

CDS Club 100 Grant Fund - Individuals

CDS Club 100 Grants are available to Chapter functions for CDS Youths and to Junior/Young Rider Individuals as well.

CDS has set aside certain Club 100 funds each calendar year for this purpose. CDS would like to support junior riders and young riders who are competing at a minimum of Training Level. The Grant money can be used for any dressage educational purpose. If your chapter is interested in a Club 100 Grant, please send in this application on or before July 31st. Both rider and owner must be members of CDS in good standing to be eligible for grants.

In 1996 Club 100 was established as tool for juniors to have available as many educational activities as possible. Chapters are encouraged to provide both mounted and unmounted activities. The Club 100 funds can be applied for by CDS chapters to defray costs.

There is also \$3,000 per year available to individual junior/young riders. \$100 will be given to 30 juniors/young riders wanting help with lessons or costs for an educational event. Anyone wanting to participate must apply and payment must be made directly to the event or clinician. Applications may be submitted at any time. Both rider and owner must be members of CDS in good standing to be eligible for grants.
